The institution has created an online platform in its website to receive feedbacks as well as suggestions from three stakeholders viz. students, teachers and alumni. The feedback forms has been created with following dimensions.

- Students' general feedback on college
- Students' feedback on teacher
- Teachers' feedback on college and curriculum
- Alumni feedback on college and curriculum

The feedbacks received are analyzed and necessary action is taken through proper channel. With regard to feedback on curriculum, academic performance of teachers and ambience of the institution following actions have been taken by IQAC after relevant discussion in IQAC. The action taken report has been handed over to Governing body for their approval.

Following actions are being taken:

- In post-pandemic phase, teachers are requested to focus more on ICT based teaching-learning.
- It is noted that departments have organised parent-teacher meeting in regularly. They are encouraged to organise the same more in number as the students' academic performance is degrading in post-pandemic phase.
- Keeping in mind the suggestions of NEP 2020, participative learning is emphasized.
- All Heads of the Departments are requested to monitor the academic performance and ambience of their respective departments and report to the Principal.
- Teachers have to upload study materials. PPTs more in number.
- Remedial classes to be continued for the sake of slow learners.
- The Principal asked Convenor of Academic Sub-Committee to collect report on completion of syllabus, internal examinations, departmental academic activities of teachers and students and other related issues.
- Emphasis is given on conducting short-term academic projects both students to facilitate interactive teaching-learning process.
- Near about 1500 books, 7 magazines have been purchased for central and departmental libraries..
- Departmental libraries are set up.
- KOHA software installation process is in progress.
- Library user orientation programme has been organised. National Librarian's Day has been observed.
- The college encourage teachers to participate in various seminars, conferences, faculty development programmes like FIP, RC. Teachers are also encouraged to admit in Ph.D. programme.
- Computer for students has been purchased. The college is planning to purchase more computers for students. Bandwidth of wi-fi to be enhanced.

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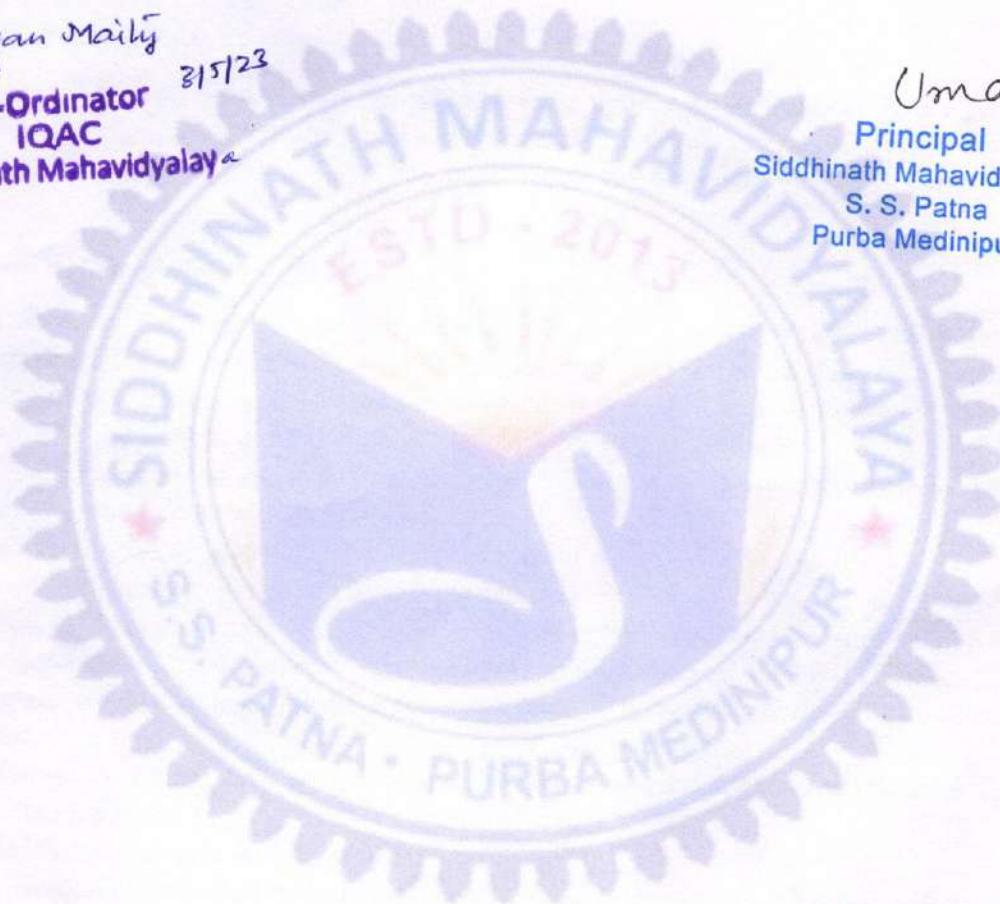
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- College has expressed thanks to Gobinda Prasad Kar, GB member for donating a vending machine.

- During lockdown/pandemic period more ICT-oriented and digital learning system is focused.
- Teachers are requested to take more online classes abiding the departmental routine during lockdown. After partial opening of college, they have taken classes in blended mode.
- Teachers have been asked to upload more study materials/learning modalities for uploading in LMS for easy access of students.
- Teachers have regularly communicated students through WhatsApp groups. Notifications from affiliating university regarding syllabus reduction, internal and final exams are regularly shared with students.
- Emphasis given on arranging counselling programmes to eradicate the trauma of students affected by pandemic.
- The departments have to organise student seminars.
- Departments have already organised webinars/ workshops/ invited talks using online platforms. They are encouraged to do the same in future.
- Teachers and students are encouraged to participate in online lectures, webinars etc. to strengthen their academic knowledge and expertise.
- Remedial classes have been taken during pandemic for slow learners.
- Books and magazines have already been purchased for Central library. More to be

- Besides, the Principal after discussing with Governing Body members asked all faculties to address the issue of maintaining COVID protocol within the campus after getting the circular of college reopening in the month of November 2021.
